Basic Beanie worked Flat or In the Round

SIZE	HEAD CIRCUMFERENCE	YARN REQUIRED
Baby	40cm/16"	75mtr
Toddler	45cm/18"	95mtr
3-8 years	50cm/20"	105mtr
9-12 years	52cm/21"	120mtr
Ladies	55cm/22"	160mtr
Mens	60cm/24"	180mtr

Equipment

For working in the round

3.5mm x 40cm circular

4mm x 40cm circular

4mm double pointed needles

or 80cm circular needle to work Magic Loop technique

For working flat

3.5mm needles

4mm needle

Abbreviations

k	=	knit
p	=	purl
BOR	=	beginning of round marker
K2tog	=	knit 2 tog
Dpn	=	double pointed needles

INSTRUCTIONS

In The Round

Using 3.5mm x 40cm circular needle cast on 72, (80, 88, 96, 104, 112)sts.

Being careful not to twist stitches join in the round and place BOR marker.

Rnd 1: (k2, p2) repeat to end.

Repeat Rnd 1 for a total of 20, (24, 24, 26, 30, 34) rounds.

Change to 4mm x 40cm circular needle

Rnd 1: knit to end

Repeat Rnd 1 until hat measures 12.5(14, 14.5, 17, 19, 20)cm from the cast on edge.

Crown

Rnd 1: [knit 7,(8, 9, 10, 11,12), k2tog]x8

Rnd 2: knit to end

Continue to decrease 8 stitches every other round as established by working one stitch less between k2tog decreases until 32 stitches remain. Change to dpns or Magic Loop technique as required.

Decrease every round in established pattern until 8 stitches remain.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches.

Fasten and darn in yarn ends.

INSTRUCTIONS

Flat

Using 3.5mm needles cast on 74, (82, 90, 98, 106, 114)sts.

Row 1: k1, (p2, k2) repeat to last stitch, k1

Row 2: p1, (p2, k2) repeat to last stitch, p1

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for a total of 20, (24, 24, 26, 30, 34) rows

Change to 4mm needles

Row 1: knit to end

Row 2: purl to end

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until hat measures 12.5(14, 14.5, 17, 19, 20)cm from the cast on edge.

Crown

Row 1: k1, [knit 7,(8, 9, 10, 11,12), k2tog]x8, k1

Row 2: purl to end

Continue to decrease 8 stitches every other row as established by working one stitch less between k2tog decreases until 32 stitches remain.

For All Sizes

Row 1: k1, (k2, k2tog)x8, k1

Row 2: p1, (p1, p2tog)x8, p1

Row 3: k1, (k2tog)x8, k1

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches.

Sew up the back seam and darn in yarn ends.
