

# **SUPER CHUNKY CROCHET HAT**

(PLUS INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE IN ARAN OR CHUNKY)

### **Materials**

200g Super Chunky Yarn (160mtr) 10mm Crochet Hook Large Pom Pom (circa 9cm)

# **Measurements**

To fit average size ladies head 57-59cm (22" – 23")

# **Abreviations** (English)

st = stitch ch = chain slst = slip stitch dc = double crochet dc2tog = double crochet 2 together



### **Instructions**

Foundation: Ch 30

Row 1: Ch1 (does not count as a stitch), 1dc in each stitch to end, turn

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as a stitch), 1dc in back loop of each stitch to end, turn

Rows 3-45: Repeat Row 2

#### **Joining Seam**

Bring the cast on edge up to meet the last row worked and join the two edges by working a slip stitch through the back loop of stitch in previous row and the front loop of the foundation chain, repeat to end, fasten off.

# **Closing Top**

Turn the hat inside out so the seam is on the inside.

**Rnd 1:** With right side facing rejoin yarn with a slst to the top of the seam, dc2tog using the next 2 row ends, repeat to end, [22 sts]

**Rnd 2:** Dc2tog using the next 2 row ends, repeat to end, [12 sts].

Weave end through last 12sts and pull to close, securely sew in end.

# Pom pom

Make a large pom pom (circa 9cm diameter) and attach to top

# To make this hat in Aran yarn

### **Materials**

200g Aran Yarn 5mm Crochet Hook Large Pom Pom (circa 9cm)

### Instructions

### Follow the instructions process for the Super Chunky

Foundation: Ch 50

Follow Super Chunky instructions but complete rows until the piece is big enough to create a snug fit round your head. (Approx 90ish rows depending on size desired).

# To make this hat in Chunky yarn

# **Materials**

200g Chunky Yarn 6mm Crochet Hook Large Pom Pom (circa 9cm)

### **Instructions**

### Follow the instructions process for the Super Chunky

Foundation: Ch 40

Follow Super Chunky instructions but complete rows until the piece is big enough to create a snug fit round your head. (Approx 70ish rows depending on size desired).
