A 3½mm (UK 9 - USA E/4) crochet hook, stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

FPtr front post treble: yoh, insert hook from tr2tog yoh, insert hook in first st, yoh and front and from right to left around stem of next st, yoh and draw a loop through, (yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice BPtr back post treble: yoh, insert hook from back and from right to left around stem of next st, yoh and draw a loop through, (yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice dc2tog insert hook in first st, yoh and draw a loop through, insert hook in next st, yoh and draw a loop through, yoh and pull through all 3 loops on hook

draw a loop through, yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook, yoh, insert hook in next st, yoh and draw a loop through, yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook, yoh and pull through all 3 loops on hook

tr3tog yoh, insert hook in first st, yoh and draw a loop through, yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook, (yoh, insert hook in next st, yoh and draw a loop through, yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice, yoh and pull through all 4 loops on hook.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

21 tr and 13 rows to 10cm, 4in, over rows of trebles on 3½mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always crochet a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to a finer hook. If there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to a larger hook.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.

SWEATER both versions BACK

Using 3½mm hook and MC, make 96[108:118:130:140:150] ch (not including slip knot).

Circle the

size you wish

to make

Row 1 (ws): 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each ch to end, turn. 95[107:117:129:139:149] dc.

***Row 2: 3ch (counts as 1tr throughout), *FPtr around next st, 1dc in next dc; rep from * to end of row, turn

Row 3: 3ch, BPtr around FPtr below, *1dc in next dc, BPtr around next FPtr below; rep from * to tch, 1dc in 3rd of 3ch. turn.

Row 4: 3ch, FPtr around BPtr below, *1dc in next dc, FPtr around next BPtr below; rep from * to tch, 1dc in 3rd of 3ch, turn.

Rep row 3 again.

Dec row (rs): 3ch, miss st at base of ch, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, tr2tog, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 94[106:116:128:138:148] tr.

Next row (ws): 3ch, miss st at base of ch, 1tr in each st to last st, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn.

Repeating this row makes rows of trs. Place a marker in rs of work to indicate rs and ws later.****

Cont in rows of trs until work measures 38[38:40:42:43:44] cm, 15[15:15¾:16½:17:17½] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape raglan armholes

Next row (rs): 1ch (does not count as a st), sl st in st at base of ch and in each of next 7[7:9:9:11:11] sts, 3ch, 1tr in each of next 77[89:95:107:113:123] sts, turn (leaving 8[8:10:10:12:12] unworked sts at end). 78[90:96:108:114:124] tr.

Dec row: 3ch, tr3tog worked over next 3 sts. 1tr in each st to last 4 sts. tr3tog worked over next 3 sts, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 74[86:92:104:110:120]tr. Rep the last row 0[3:4:8:9:12] times. 74[74:76:72:74:72] tr.

Dec row: 3ch, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 72[72:74:70:72:70] tr.** Rep the last row 21[20:21:17:18:17] times. 30[32:32:36:36:36] tr. Cut yarn and fasten off.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **. 72[72:74:70:72:70] tr. Rep the last row 12[11:12:8:9:8] times, ending with a **rs** row. 48[50:50:54:54:54] tr.

Shape neck

Dec row (ws): 3ch, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in each of next 13 sts, turn. 15 tr.

*****Dec row:** 3ch, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 13 tr.

Rep the last row 4 more times. 5 tr. Work 3 rows, dec 1 st as set at raglan edge only on each row. 2 tr. Cut yarn and fasten off.

With **ws** of work facing, miss next 16[18:18:22:22:22] sts, rejoin yarn into next st and work second side of neck as follows:

Dec row (ws): 3ch, miss st at base of ch, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 15 tr.

Work as given for first side of neck from ***.

SLEEVES

Using 3½mm hook and MC, make 44[46:48:50:52:52] ch (not including slip knot).

Row 1 (ws): 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each ch to end, turn. 43[45:47:49:51:51] dc. Work as given for Back from *** to

****. 42[44:46:48:50:50] tr. Work 2 more rows of trs.

Inc row: 3ch, miss st at base of ch, 2tr in next st, 1tr in each st to last 2 sts, 2tr in next st, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 44[46:48:50:52:52] tr.

Cont in rows of trs, inc 1 st as set at each end of every foll 3rd row to 72[76:68:68:66:60] tr.

For 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Cont in rows of trs, inc 1 st as set at each end of every foll 2nd row to [84:88:92:96] tr.

For all sizes

Cont in rows of trs without shaping until Sleeve measures 46[46:47:48:48:48] cm, 18[18:18½:19:19] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape top

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Next row (rs): 1ch (does not count as a st), sl st in st at base of ch and in each of next 7[7:9:9:11:11] sts, 3ch, 1tr in each of next 55[59:63:67:67:71] sts, turn (leaving 8[8:10:10:12:12] unworked sts at end). 56[60:64:68:68:72] tr.

Dec row: 3ch, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, tr2tog worked over next 2 sts, 1tr in 3rd of 3ch, turn. 54[58:62:66:66:70] tr. Work 1 row of trs. Rep the last 2 rows 2[3:3:2:4:4] more

times. 50[52:56:62:58:62] tr. Work 17[17:19:21:19:21] rows of trs, dec 1 st as set at each end of every row. 16[18:18:20:20:20] tr. Cut yarn and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Sew sleeves to back and front by joining raglan seams.

Neckband

Using 3½mm hook and MC, starting at Left back raglan seam, work in rnds as follows:

Next rnd (rs): 1ch (does not count as a st), 1dc in each of next 16[18:18:20:20:20] sts across Left sleeve top, 15dc evenly down side of neck, 16[18:18:22:22:22]dc across Front neck, 15dc evenly up side of neck, 16[18:18:20:20:20]dc across Right sleeve top and 30[32:32:36:36:36]dc across Back neck, sl st in first dc to join. 108[116:116:128:128:128] dc.

Next rnd: 3ch, FPtr around next st, *1dc in next st, FPtr around next st; rep from * to end of round, sl st in 3rd of 3ch to join.

Rep the last rnd 3 more times. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Join side and sleeve seams. Pin out sweater to measurements given.

Cover with a clean damp tea towel and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions. z —

SWEATER WITH MISTLETOE Leaves (make 19)

Using 3½mm hook and CC1, *make 16ch, miss 5ch, 1trtr in each of next 3ch, 1dtr in each of next 2ch, 1tr in each of next 2ch, 1htr in next ch,1dc in each of next 2ch; rep from * once more, sl st in rem first ch. Do not fasten off.

Stem Row: Make 9ch (attached to end of final st on Leaves), miss 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end. Cut yarn and fasten off, leaving a long yarn end for sewing onto sweater.

Berries (make 50)

Note: start each Berry with a different colour in MC. Berries are worked in a spiral so place a marker at end of rnd.


Using 3½mm hook and MC, make a magic ring, leaving a long yarn end for sewing onto sweater.

Row 1 (rs): 6dc into ring. 6 dc. Row 2: 2dc in each dc to end. 12 dc. Row 3: 1dc in each dc to end. Row 4: (Dc2tog) 6 times. 6 dc. Cut yarn and fasten off, leaving a long yarn end. Weave yarn end through tops of last 6dc and pull tight. Secure the yarn and use the yarn end to stuff the Berry.

Using the photographs for guidance, sew the mistletoe leaves evenly around the neck. Sew on the berries randomly.
